BEST IN SWEEPS. Good type of Border, narrow and really moved out. Strong drive from the rear with plenty of reach, nice level topline while on the move.

Hammish Liked head and expression, nice, large teeth.

1) Redgate's Panic Button—

BOS to BEST IN SWEEPS. Nice, moderate, young bitch. Moved nicely, had very good bone and substance. Good head and expression and a proper tail.

2) Kevrah Star Magnolia

Different type than first place bitch, tough decision between the two. Nice and narrow, moved well, good rear angulation with well let-down hocks.

3) Peaceable Clover Nicely

Nice bitch puppy, good bone and head with large teeth. Good hide.

4) Peaceable Branston Sweet

Same comments apply as third placement. Nice type on third and fourth placements. They had many

good things going for them.

On the day, first and second placements had more maturity. I would enjoy judging them at a later date. A nice class.
