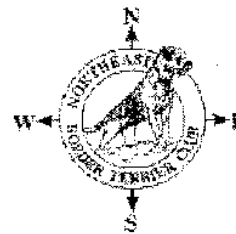

NBTC Hosts BTCA Specialty

Ideal weather, a grand site and warm NE Hospitality combine to make a memorable week

Some random observations:

Remarks overheard: [7:30 AM at the onsite hospitality breakfast] "Aw! Who ate all the blueberry muffins?" [10:30 AM, at a shady picnic table outside]: "Well, time for my chowder fix!" [1:00 PM, hanging out] "You guys going to today's seminar? "Anybody going to the laundromat later?" "I'm going to beat Chris Dyer at tennis--wait and see!" "You get your dog DNA'd yet?" "I think the people you want are on the far side of the pond. Look for the ID signs in their RV space, or ask Paul LaVoie--he set up the whole thing." "Anybody want to swap a blue XL Specialty tee for my yellow one?" [Late evening, a voice in the dark onsite] "Uh-oh. Anybody got a poop bag?"

Notable glimpses:

On the Sunday before the show began: in the roomy onsite function room, late afternoon (which has the air of the gym before prom night): Pam Dyer everywhere; Jean Clark on a ladder mounting the raffle quilts on the wall; Jenny Chambers placing flowers on tables; Jocelyne Tasse-Durocher and Marnie Fielding conferring intently going through a hospitality checklist; Donna Moore-LaVoie and an assembly line of helpers rapidly unfolding and stuffing a mountain of exhibitor bags and stacking them for distribution; at the entrance: Paul LaVoie, with clipboard, greeting arrivals and directing them to assigned places in his carefully designed Border Village, which had pathways, neighborhoods, little private spaces for each RV, and in some cases pond edge real estate. **On opening day:** at the catalog tent: Show Secretary Holly Woodward, in a wide straw hat, her BT Reggie sitting at her feet, patiently coping with catalog sales, queries, and requests from an endless string of new arrivals; at the exhibition tent (**any day**): BTs being "held" (mostly on laps) before or after their ring stint by the nearest handy BT person, stranger or not; Jean Lareau and Sheila Demers working intently to distribute accurately a huge cornucopia of trophies; new examples of crate chic--this year's most notable being a light-

weight, collapsible nylon-screening-and-cloth setup); youngster Kerri Steinbacher, hauling a heavy cooler from which she offered ice-pops to ringsiders; **most days**, in mellow late-afternoon sun: BTs swimming in the pond (or deciding not to); on one of the days, lure-coursing; **after dark:** in the field or at its wooded fringes: the wandering flashlight beams of onsite BT people walking their dogs ("the trick is to keep the light on his butt, see, so you can locate and pick up his--er--contribution"); **at the AGM:** talented, ever reliable BTCA secretary JoAnn Frier -Murza, steadily tapping AGM minutes into her laptop throughout the long meeting; **at the banquet:** applause for Jim Robinson and Kevin Cushman's witty BT-adapted rendition of Gilbert and Sullivan's "I Am the Very Model of a Model Major General" (when they heard the host hotel didn't have a piano, they hauled a portable one all the way from Michigan); a powerful standing ovation for Kate Seemann following Marg Pough's eloquent tribute; **at show's end:** a steady stream of well-filled departing vehicles, none perhaps as dramatically loaded as Jenny Chambers', with its heavy roofload of borrowed obedience equipment plus an attached trailer stuffed with hospitality equipment.

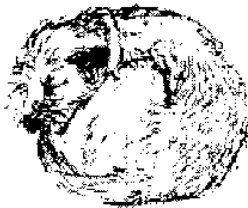
